(Pamplemousses Gardens, Port Louis (local market, Caudan Waterfront)

The Pamplemousses botanical gardens are known to naturalists throughout the world for their large collection of exotic and endemic plants.

Port Louis, the capital and commercial city of the island, was founded by the French Governor Mahé de Labourdonnais in 1735. It's historical monuments, witnesses of its past splendour, whereas its economic development can be seen in the activities around the harbour.

Stop for shopping at the Caudan Waterfront, a brand new commercial complex where all the trendiest shops are grouped.

Pamplemousses Garden, Port Louis, (Pere Laval, Kylasson Temple, Pagoda, Champs de Mars, La Citadelle, local market)

Start the day by enjoying the peacefulness of the famous Pamplemousses gardens ranking among the finest botanical garden in the world. It was started by Mahe de Labourdonnais in 1735.

Port Louis was founded during the French Colonial period. It's numerous religious buildings reflect the diversity of the Mauritian nation. Experience the lively atmosphere of the market full of bright colours and fragrances.

At Pere Laval, you will discover the shrine built in honour of Father Jacques Désiré Laval, a popular Catholic missionary.

On the way to La Citadelle, the old Fort which overlooks the capital, you will stop at a Kylasson Temple and at a Chinese Pagoda situated near le Champ de Mars, the oldest horseracing track of the southern hemisphere.

TRADITIONAL EXCURSIONS HALF & FULL DAY EXCURSION COLOURFUL PALETTE

(Trou aux Cerfs, Curepipe, Grand Bassin, Black River Gorges, Chamarel Coloured Earths)

Trou aux Cerfs is an extinct volcano, 700 000 years old, in the middle of the Central Plateau and the town of Curepipe. Enjoy the panoramic views, starting over the main towns and extending to the Moka range of mountains and the northwest coastline. The steep crater ends in a natural lake.

Drive along the Plaine Champagne road to Grand Bassin. The Hindus in Mauritius consider Grand Basin as a sacred lake. It is said that the water inside the crater with that of India's holy Ganges. A pilgrimage to this place of worship is held every year to celebrate Maha Shivarati (Lord Shiva's Great Night).

Enjoy the view of the Black River Gorges, the largest National Park in Mauritius and primary habitat of some unique species of endemic plants and rare birds like the Pink Pigeon, the Kestrel and the Mauritian Fody.

Located in the southwest of the island, at approximately 400m above sea level, Chamarel offers an amazing landscape. The village is home to two natural wonders – the waterfall of a 100 metre drop and the seven Coloured Earths, a rare natural phenomenon.

TRADITIONAL EXCURSIONS FULL DAY EXCURSION SOUTHERN ESCAPE

(Bois Cheri, Saint Aubin, Gris-Gris)

Through this excursion, discover the untamed beauty of the South.

Drive through tea plantations to the village of Bois Cheri and its tea factory, the biggest in Mauritius. After watching the processing of leaves of this plant grown there since 1892, take a guided tour through the history of tea at the museum. You can also taste a range of teas at the Bois Chéri Chalet whilst enjoying the panoramic view of the south of the island

Saint Aubin is a private-owned plantation house that was built in 1819. Converted since then into a table d'hôte, it welcomes visitors for a typical Mauritian lunch. Guests can also visit the Anthurium nursery, the Vanilla House and the rum museum.

Continue to Souillac, a small coastal village cherished by many of our poets.

Gris Gris offers some breathtaking sights of thick waves crashing directly against the sea cliffs of the untamed south. The squashing of waves against the flanks of the cliff at the spectacular 'Roche qui Pleure' gives the impression that it is weeping.

Visit of Le Vanille Réserve des Mascareignes. La Vanille Réserve des Mascareignes at Rivière des Anguilles specialises in the breeding

of Nile crocodiles. It is also home to giant tortoises as well as lush tropical fauna and flora. The park comprises a fascinating collection of butterflies and other brightly-coloured insects, a restaurant and souvenir shop for locally-manufactured crocodile products.
